WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

Towards the end of last year, larch woodland near the chapel and library of Innerpeffray near Crieff was felled. Local community groups have since been working to build a new footpath and are now planting an educational woodland and heritage trail themed to the library. Around 40 trees have been donated and the group are keen to get these planted by the end of March. The project is supported by the Perth and Kinross Countryside Trust, who put me into contact with the Innerpeffray team and their woodland subgroup directly. I am delighted to announce that we have kindly been invited to help planting these trees at Innerpeffray. The event will run for approximately an hour and a half, and refreshments will be served. The exertion level will be 2/3. I hope to see you there!
