WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

South Perth Greenspace Group have kindly invited us to join in on their **coppicing workday** in November. For the third year in a row, the group will be coppicing small trees in an area of **Craigie Community Woodland** to encourage the regrowth of more small stems. These new, young stems become sites favoured by birds for nesting, while also creating a **diverse woodland** with trees of different ages. All cut off branches will be reused as fencing, and stumps will produce new shoots in the spring.

For us Tree Wardens, this event will tie in nicely with the Tree Council's National Tree Week. Welcome!
